<b>Incentives</b>	Why am I using GFNA Training Materials?	
	Have I clearly stated what I hope to achieve in implementing GFNA? How will I know if I have achieved these things?	
<b>Skills and knowledge</b>	Do I feel I have the skills I need to use the GFNA Materials? How will I acquire the skills that I do not have at the moment?	
	Do I feel I have the knowledge I need to use the GFNA Materials? How will I acquire the knowledge that I do not have at the moment?	
<b>Resources</b>	When will I plan the program I will use?	
	What materials will I need for the activities I have planned and where can I get them?	

	What will GFNA replace – what will I be able to stop doing because GFNA enables participants to better achieve understandings of the needs of new arrivals?	
<b>Collegial support</b>	Who on staff will I talk to if I need support with the information?	
	Who on staff will I talk to if I need support with activities?	
	Who on staff will I talk to if I need support in interpreting participants' responses?	
	Who on staff will I talk to if I need encouragement or I have something to celebrate?	
<b>Other support</b>	What will I tell my organisation about the GFNA Training program?
